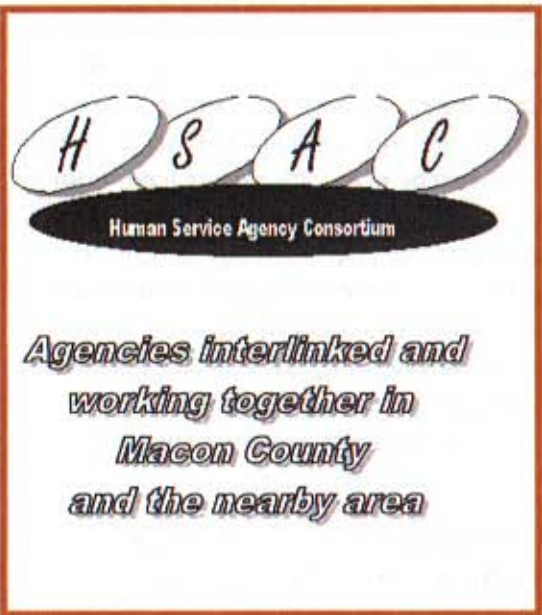

HSAC Benefits

HSAC members are representatives of human service agencies and other interested individuals from Macon County and the nearby area. Members have come together since its founding in 1988 for general membership meetings on the first Thursday of most months to network and to learn from speakers on diverse topics of mutual interest. HSAC promotes collaborative efforts that benefit community residents and strengthens human services by:

- Providing a forum for information exchange and agency collaboration at monthly meetings.
- Offering affordable professional trainings with topics such as diversity, grant writing, coalition building, stress management, public speaking, and volunteer coordinator training.
- Recognizing at an annual awards luncheon, outstanding agencies and individuals who address our community's human service needs.
- Providing grant and resource information and opportunities for member agencies and their programs.



HSAC Divisions

HSAC Divisions are the action part of the organization. Division members work to identify important human service issues and to improve the quality of life in our community. These divisions meet regularly to network and develop a vision for coordinated delivery of human services to citizens of Macon County and the nearby area.

Disability Division members represent agencies dedicated to providing services to individuals with disabilities. It meets five times a year at various agencies to network and to address disability issues such as transition from high school, disability awareness, support groups, housing for disabled persons, and disability-related legislation.

Senior Division members represent many agencies dedicated to improving the lives of area seniors while making the community more aware of the needs of the senior population. It has addressed such issues as Alzheimer Disease Research.

Youth and Family Division members represent many agencies dedicated to helping our youth grow up in healthy family environments and working to educate Macon County residents on youth and family issues.

Volunteer Division members represent many agencies that utilize and encourage volunteers in their own and in other human service agencies. It has coordinated volunteer workshops and provided funds for members to attend conferences in the Central Illinois area.

HSAC Programs

Teddy Bear Dental Care is a program that began in 1999 to help fulfill an identified community need for treating severe dental needs of children from lower-income families who have no dental insurance. It has already helped over 125 children. Minimally funded by HSAC, it primarily relies on individual donations that are generated at an annual fund-raiser. HSAC member representatives annually elect officers who then appoint committee chairs. A board consisting of the officers, committee chairs and division chairs meets monthly, organizes an annual awards luncheon, and approves budget items. HSAC committees include: Documents, Grants, Membership, Nominating, Professional Development, Program, and Recognition. Committee chairs select their members and meet as appropriate. Divisions select their own leaders, agenda, projects and meeting items and places.
