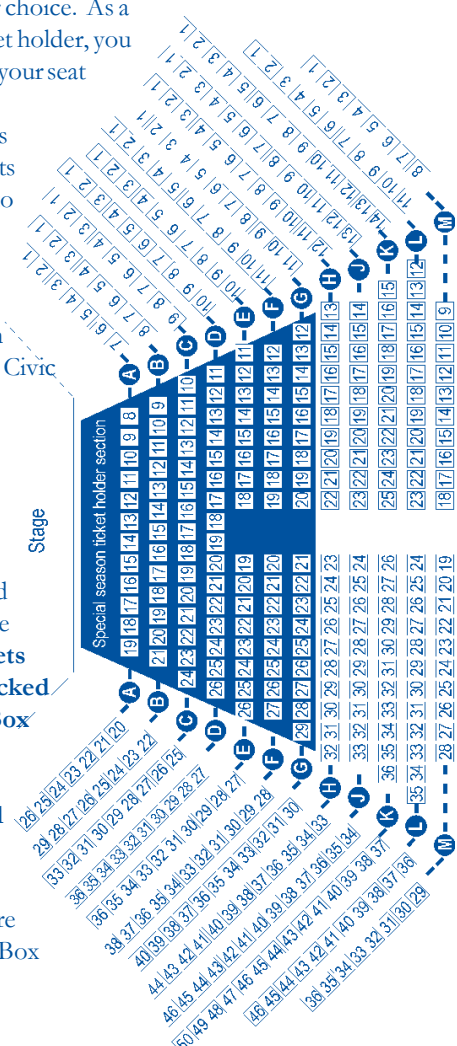

- **By mail** - following the directions below.
- **In-person** - at the Civic Center Box Office.
- **By phone:** using your VISA or MasterCard (call 422-6161).
- **You must first fill out the order form and mail it with your check.**
- A special reserved section will be available for season ticket holders up to one week prior to opening night, at which time those seats will be available to the public. No guarantee of preferential seating can be made after that time. Simply redeem your season ticket at the Civic Center Box Office for the date and seat of your choice. As a season ticket holder, you can reserve your seat for all three productions before tickets go on sale to the public.
- You can also mail your season ticket to the Civic Center Box Office, P.O. Box 380, Decatur, IL 62525, indicating your desired performance date. **Tickets must be picked up at the Box Office in person; no tickets will be mailed.**
- Check your tickets before leaving the Box Office.
